Position Summary: The Chicago, IL chapter of the National Asian Pacific American Women's Forum seeks an energetic consultant to help develop and implement an groundbreaking Asian and Pacific Islander (API) Reproductive Justice (RJ) focused community survey project. The two-fold purpose of the project is to a) better understand the current reproductive justice needs and priorities of API women and girls in Chicago and; b) strengthen the API community in Chicago by creating linkages between organizations where API women and girls access services.

NAPAWF seeks a capable consultant to assist in all aspects of the planning and implementation of this project. This will include assisting with survey development, data gathering from API women leaders and allies, conducting follow-up interviews, collecting and compiling information, and producing a written report of results. The consultant will work collaboratively with NAPAWF-Chicago board members and have substantial opportunity to help shape and direct survey project.

The timeline of the project is negotiable but must be completed by June 2012. A fee of \$1000 will be provided in addition to approved travel expenses associated with the project.

Qualifications:

- Graduate student, or college student/graduate with equivalent relevant work or non-profit experience in community-based research. Preferred fields include but not limited to: gender studies, Asian American studies, public health, sociology, non-profit management, etc.
- Excellent research, writing and verbal communication skills.
- Interest in Asian and Pacific Islander women's issues.
- Familiarity with and regular access to email and word processing.
- Self-starter who takes initiative and can work well both independently and in groups.
- Strong knowledge/advocacy of/experience with API and women's issues preferred.
